CORE 101 is a new online professional development portal to help career and technical educators connect, share best practices and integrate the Common Core State Standards into their career and technical education (CTE) programming.

ONLINE COURSE OUTLINE

Module 1

- Registration and overview of CORE 101
- Review of the English Language Arts Standards
- Review of the Mathematics Standards

Module 2

- Introduction to CORE - Collaborate, Orient, Relate and Enhance - and the process for mapping academic standards to current CTE curricula
- Participants input information about their CTE curricula lesson plans

Module 3

- Collaborate – The value of productive collaboration and sharing best practices across teacher networks
- Participants complete a self-assessment activity, called “Collaboration Factors”

Module 4

- Orient participants' curricula to the standards, identifying relevant math and ELA standards

Module 5

- Relate the standards into student-friendly questions for greater understanding of the standards to determine possible curriculum revisions

Module 6

- Enhance CTE curricula, where appropriate, to more fully address CCSS to foster student success
- Consider additional resources needed to better integrate CTE and academic programs, and how to assess college and career readiness skills



CORE 101 will give you access to a 6-module course that takes approximately 6.5 hours of direct instruction and another 8-10 hours to complete assignments with additional opportunities to:

- Interact with CTE educators across the country
- Develop and share lesson plans
- Receive assistance and mentoring from CTE instructional specialists
